Llano is located about 25 miles Southeast of [Palmdale](#) in the [Antelope Valley](#) portion of [Southern California](#). The town of [Pearblossom](#) lies to the West, while the town of [Pinon Hills](#) lies to the East. [Pearblossom Highway](#) (State Route 138) runs through the heart of Llano and is its principal street.

Llano was once the home of English writer [Aldous Huxley](#). At the turn of the 20th century there were socialist colonies in Llano, the most notable being [Job Harriman](#)'s Llano Del Rio commune. The ruins of [Llano Del Rio](#) are still extant along Highway 138 east of 165th Street East.
